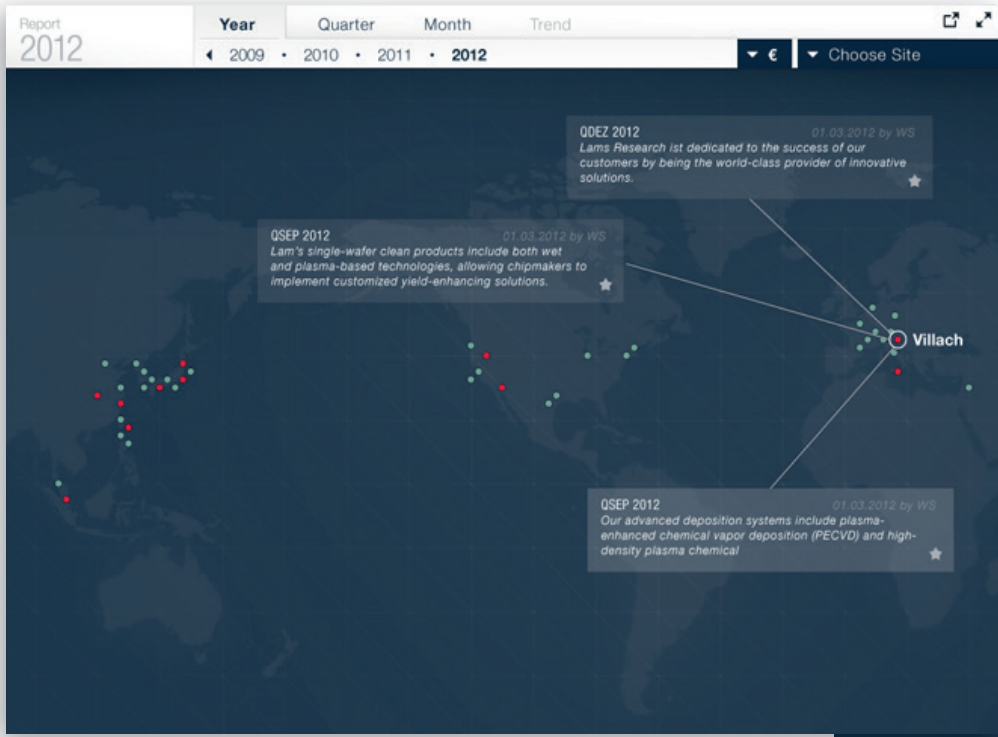

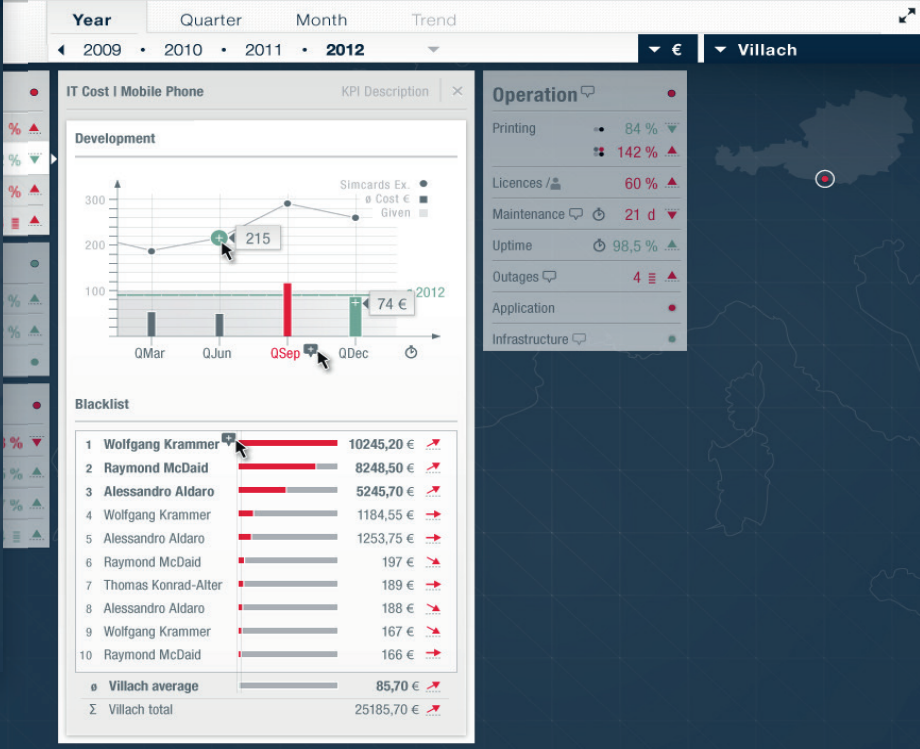

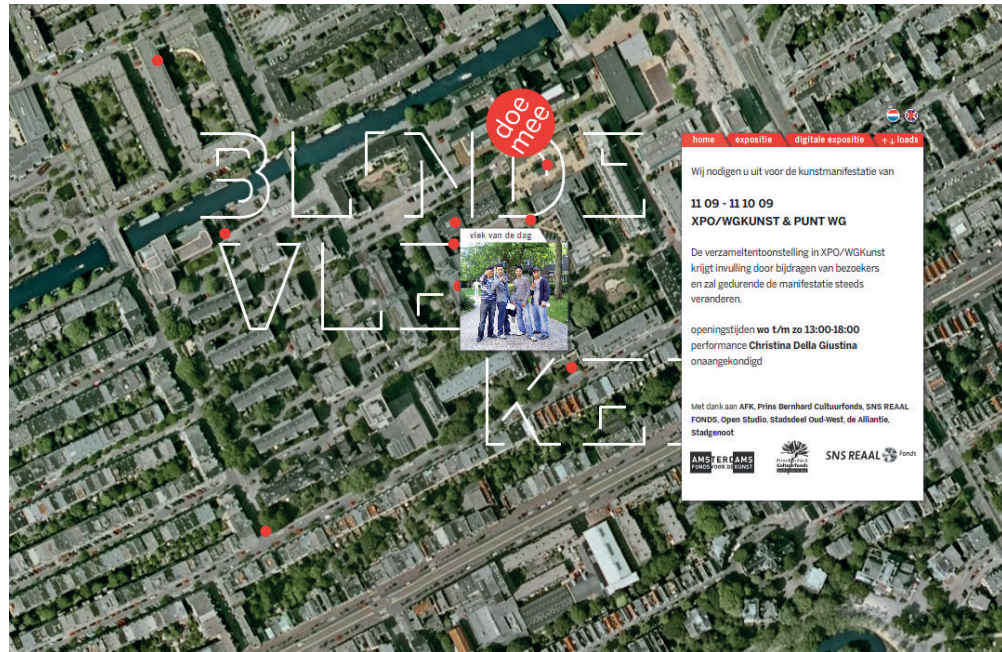

After working on some projects together, I was also asked to design the studios new website. In order to give the design projects a decent platform, the site became quite minimalist and coy.



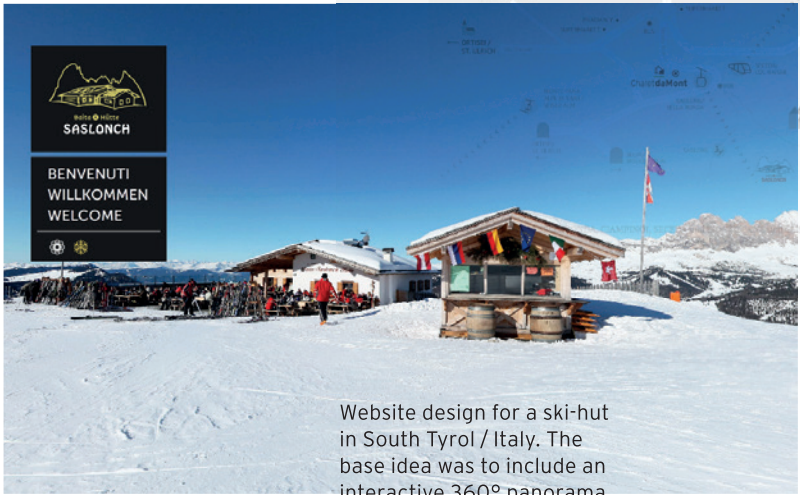
